- NCAA Eligibility Center Database.
- Federal Graduation Rates.
- NCAA Financial Reporting System.
- NCAA Membership Database.

IPP DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM BENEFITS

- Facilitates informed decision-making and strategic planning.
- Allows for timely identification of issues and trends.
- Institutions have autonomy to reach their own conclusions based on a review of data.
- Permits comparisons with peer groups.

IPP DATA MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

PEER GROUPS

- Existing peer groups (conference, division, subdivision).
- Self-selected peer groups (minimum of eight in each group):
 - Institution/conference.
 - Enrollment.
 - Budget level.
 - By sport.
 - By number of sports sponsored.
 - Public/private.

REVIEW OF DATA

- Annual, broad-based review of the data.
- Consider providing access to the following:
 - Athletics director;
 - Chief financial officer;
 - Director of student-athlete academic support;
 - Faculty athletics representative;
 - Provost/registrar;
 - Senior woman administrator; and
 - Title IX/diversity officers.
